- Service Incidents — *A review of LESD service interruptions since last meeting*

- E-Rate — *Quick recap of any news this month*
  - ESD has historically filed for e-rate as a school district since we don't pass costs on to individual districts for ISP or transport circuits. SLD is now recommending that the ESD apply as a consortium for those services. Superintendents were presented with Letters of Agency at their meeting this week, and most signed. There will be another form collected from district in the next few months that will allow us to make CIPA certifications on behalf of each district, so technology coordinators may get questions about that piece (the form asks for acknowledgment that the district complies with CIPA).

- Marcola demo-ing an interactive TV. Eugene has Smart flatpanel tvs, but they work best with Microsoft. Piloting Mondoboard, don't like that it's essentially a PC built into a big monitor, hardware is locked into the unit, so they are skeptical about the lifespan of the monitor itself.
